In April 2003, The Port issued its first financing in the amount of \$50 million in tax-exempt bonds to the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center for the construction of this new cultural institution. Opened in August 2004 and employing more than 100 people, the Freedom Center welcomed more than 355,000 visitors in its first eighteen months of operation.
