One of the largest buildings in Northside, the American Can Building was used for tin can making machine manufacturing from 1921 until 1961 and then served as a machine shop. The Port secured a grant to remediate asbestos and PCB contamination to enable its conversion into 93 market-rate apartments and 30,000 SF of commercial space.
