REACH

The Port Authority's REACH Program was developed to to holistically implement full-neighborhood residential redevelopment.

REACH – Rehab Across Cincinnati & Hamilton County – is one of several programs the Port Authority uses to promote enduring Hamilton County neighborhoods where families feel safe, have expanded employment opportunities, and greater access to viable housing options.

REACH launched in 2014 in Evanston. Focusing on target areas within neighborhoods, the goal of REACH is to stabilize housing stock in neighborhoods, many of which have seen a long-term decline in housing value.
